Current College Student

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The Oregon Narcotics Enforcement Association (ONEA) is committed to contributing to the health and welfare and the professional, personal, and academic growth of its members and their families. As part of that commitment, ONEA provides one competitive \$1,500 college scholarship annually to a qualified college student who is attending an accredited community college or university and who is the dependent of a current ONEA member.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

To apply for the scholarship, the applicant must meet the following qualifications:

- 1. Dependent of a current ONEA member;
- 2. College student attending an accredited community college or university, and;
- 3. Cumulative college grade point average (GPA) of 2.75 or better at the time of application.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

To be considered for the scholarship, the following must be included in the application packet:

- 1. Completed application form which is available on the ONEA web site home page at <u>www.onea.org</u>;
- 2. College transcript showing cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better;
- 3. Two letters of recommendation; one from a college instructor and one from a community member who is not related to the applicant;
- 4. Letter of interest that is no longer than two (2) pages in length which includes the applicant's biography and academic and career plans;
- 5. A personal resume that includes academic and extracurricular history and accomplishments, community involvement, and work history.

EVALUATION AND AWARD PROCEDURES:

The ONEA Scholarship Committee will review the application materials in May and will award the scholarship by June 1st. All applicants will be notified of the outcome of the process in writing. The awarded scholarship funds will be sent to the recipient's college or university financial aid office upon enrollment for the upcoming academic year.

REQUIRED ATTACHMENTS

- **#** Current college transcript showing a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better.
- Two letters of recommendation; one from a college instructor and one from a community member who is not related to the applicant.
- Letter of interest that is no longer than two (2) pages in length that includes biography and academic and career plans.
- **H** A personal resume that includes academic and extracurricular history and accomplishments, community involvement, and work history.
